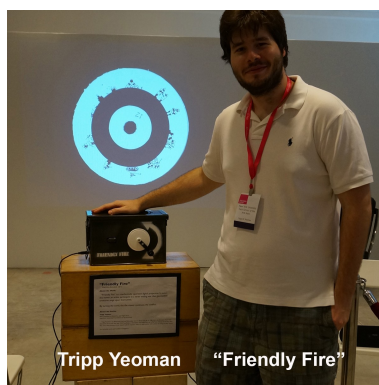
- **New York University Tisch School of the Arts Asia Animation and Digital Arts Department at the Affordable Art Fair in Singapore**

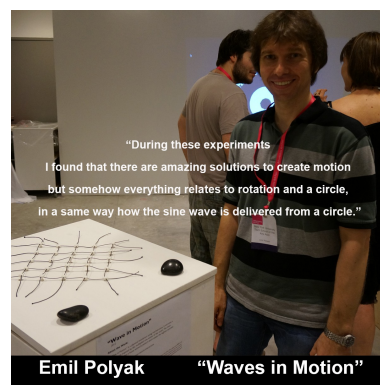
